## MAIN TASKS:

**Under the supervision of team members, interns will have the following tasks:**

- Support for advocacy activities; preparation of press conferences, public interventions or memos;
- Support in implementing the daily protection of whistleblowers
- Support in monitoring and investigating cases denounced by whistleblowers
- Support in the follow-up of ongoing judicial and extra-judicial litigation cases
- Support for communication activities around our main projects;
- Monitoring news and legal developments regarding whistleblowers
- Occasional support in various projects carried out by the PPLAAF's team and in PPLAAF's cross-functional activities.

- Master 2 student in law, political science, social sciences, economy/finance or journalism.
- Fluency in French and English. Knowledge of languages commonly used in Africa is a plus.
- Interest in working with non-profit organisations
- Experience working on and/or living in one or several African countries a strong plus
