#### DURATION

The duration of placement for interns will be 12 Months and 18 – 24 Months for TVET learners in terms of Work Integrated Learning . Please note that this placement programme is not a permanent offer of employment, but an opportunity to acquire relevant work experience or to be issued with their diploma.

#### HOW TO APPLY?

Applicants must specify the discipline or area of specialisation they are applying for, accompanied by comprehensive curriculum vitae and certified copies of original qualifications, academic transcripts and a copy of SA ID document (Smart IDs to be copied on both sides). The certifying stamp must not be older than 6 months. Testimonial letter in case of TVET learners should also not be older than 2023 academic years.
